

BY-LAWS
OF THE
ARLINGTON OUTING CLUB

ARTICLE 1

Section 1, Qualifications:

Any person who is the head of a family in Arlington, S. D. shall be qualified to be a member and stockholder on signing the ~~BY-LAWS~~ the stock subscription list and the By-Laws.

Section 2:

No stockholder shall sell or assign his stock to any person, and all certificates of Stock after same shall have been paid, shall be retained by the President or manager.

Section 3:

Any person wishing membership in this association by the purchase of other members stock or issue of new stock, shall apply to the Secretary in writing and same shall be submitted to a meeting of the members and stockholders, a majority of whom shall be present, and if on a secret ballot, a majority of those present vote in favor ~~of~~ such person shall become a member on paying the amount fixed by the board of directors and signing the by-laws.

ARTICAL 2.

Section 1 Meetings:

The annual meeting of the Stockholders for the election of directors shall be on the second tuesday of June in each year, and two weeks notice shall be given of such meeting by publication as provided by law. Other meetings of the Stockholders and members may be held at any time on notice signed by the President or by any Five members, a majority shall constitute a quorum, and no member shall be allowed to own more than one share of stock.

Section 2:

After the annual meeting of the Stockholders, the directors elect shall meet and organize by electing one of their ~~members~~ number as President, One Secretary and One Treasurer.

Section 3:

The President, Secretary and Treasurer, shall perform the duties and services performed by such officers in all corporations, and the board of directors or a majority of same, shall have charge of the affairs of the corporation, collect any and all money due the corporation, Buy and and all property, Real and personal, and have exclusive management of the affairs of the association. They shall annually render a detailed account of the affairs of the Association and of the receipts and disbursements at the annual meeting of the Stockholders, and shall have power to do all things requisite and necessary to carry out the object and purposes of the association, supply vacancies in the board, sign all papers, Deeds and Checks, and do any and all things that directors are authorized by Law to do and not herein stated.

ARTICLE 3.

Section 1:

Each stockholder and member shall enter into a written agreement that he will not sell or assign ~~xxxxxxx~~ his certificate of stock to any person who has not been admitted ~~xx~~ into membership by a majority vote of the members as above provided, also that he will pay in addition to the capital stock, such a sum annually to maintain or repair th buildings and grounds as the directors may fix, such annual assessment shall be a lien on the stock until paid, and the association shall have right to recover such sums.

Section 2:

It being the purpose of this association to have a club house and grounds at Lake Pointset, for the purpose of pleasure, Outing and recreation, such property shall be in charge of manager selected by the board and parties wishing to

occupy rooms in club house, shall register with the manager as to room and time of occupancy. Such time to be not more than ten days continuously and in case of several wanting accomodation that can not be otherwise arranged, time of occupancy and rooms shall be decided by lot.

All keys to building or buildings and rooms shall be in charge of Manager and he shall deliver same to stockholders only, and take his receipt therefor, and should any damage be done to the property, the holder of such key shall be held responsible whether or not such member be present on the grounds or not.

Section 3:

The buildings and grounds shall at all times be accessable to the Stockholders and members and such friends as they see fit to ask to accompany them. As to use of Club room, kitchen and other buildings, should the directors p place same in charge of a house keeper, No member or visitor shall use the portin used by such house keeper and such house keeper shall have charge of the club house, all property in same and on the grounds.

Damage of any kind to the property shall be charged to occupant at the time damage is done, same by a charge on the stock of occupant.

It being understood that no member or stockholder will consider any resident of Arlington as a guest or friend to occupy the rooms in the club house, the use of which is reserved for members, their friends, and transient guests.

Section 4:

To Govern the Conduct of members and stockholders:

All members shall have access to ~~xxxxxx~~ the grounds and buildings at all times; They shall have the right to ask any friends to accompanythem; they shall have the privilege of Camping on the grounds on applying to the manager for a location they shall have the right to occupy the room in the club house assigned them by the manager; They shall at all times conduct themselves courtiously toward other members or visitors on the grounds; They shall not litter the grounds with rubbish nor hay of any kind; Shall carefully clean the Grounds of all paper, food or anything after using same for a picnic, and not permit horse manure to accumilate but shall remove or burfy same so as not to permit the breeding of flies; Use of boats , if any are owned, shall be arranged by the manager, also use of grounds for picnics, It being understood that no public gathering shall be held, and all persons not members shall be considered as guests of members who shall be responsible for their conduct, Neither members or their guestsshall use on the grounds laud or other offensive language, and not use tobacco in such a way as to offend any one, such as smoking in ~~XXX~~ club house or spitting on cement floor, nor use intoxicating liquors, meaning and intending that the grounds shall be open to all who conduct themselves in a proper manner, and in case any member violate the rules of propriety, such member may by a vote of a majority of Stockholders be expelled and his stock forfeited.

The above By-Laws can be ammended any time at a meeting of the majority of the Stockholders.
